NEW PRESIDENT

FOR MINDA INC.

Prominent Adelaide businessman, Mr Roy Arnold, has retired as President of Minda Inc. after nine years in the role.

Mr Arnold, a former Managing Director of Seeley International and a former General Manager of TransAdelaide, was appointed to the Board of Minda in 1998 as a State Government representative.

He became a Minda Association non-family member and Chairman of the Board in 2001.

Minda's Chief Executive Officer, Ms Cathy Miller, said Mr Arnold had overseen a number of major achievements during his Presidency including:

- Development of a Master Plan for the Brighton Campus, designed to meet the future needs of South Australians with intellectual disabilities through the provision of purpose-built accommodation on campus.
- Signing of the 2006 United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities. This resulted in Minda moving to a modern Person Centred Thinking approach which assists individuals living with disability to plan and build their own lives.

Mr Arnold has been succeeded as President by Minda's Chairman of the Master Plan Steering Committee and Board Director, Mr Tony Harrison.
